Sample Curriculum Vitae Outline

The purpose of the CV is to be able to chronologically track, and be able to account for, all time periods since the physician started medical training. This includes education, experience, military service, certifications, licenses, DEA information, etc. The CV should be constantly updated to reflect any changes so that it is always current. It is very helpful if you list "current as of (date)" on the CV.

What to Include in Your CV
